**Our program is located in the Health & Human Services Building in the heart of
downtown Eugene. We are part the Behavioral Health Services division under
the umbrella of the Federally Qualified Health Center.**

Who we are and what we do

The Lane County Methadone Treatment Program provides medically supervised methadone maintenance to help program participants reduce and ultimately end the maladaptive use of heroin and other opioid drugs. Our program encourages a holistic and individualized approach to personal recovery. Through individual and group counseling and therapy, we ask patients to honestly examine and assess multiple areas in their lives, which include, but are not limited to physical, psychological, social and spiritual health practices. We insist that each patient take responsibility for their life choices and actions. Therefore the program's treatment modality is considered a bio-psycho-social model. Treatment through this program is available to any Lane County resident with opioid and other drug dependencies.

Minimum requirements for this position

- Master's degree from an accredited college or university with major course work in a mental health field, psychology, counseling, social work or related field.
- Two years of responsible professional mental health experience, including one year of experience in addiction counseling or methadone treatment.
- Must present CADC within 2 years from date of hire.
- Eligible for QMHP designation at time of hire.

Documents required for this position

- Diploma
- Transcripts (unofficial is fine)
- CV or resume
- NPI (must reflect Oregon address at time of hire)
- Valid Oregon Driver's License

This position is subject to a full criminal offender information record check. If fingerprinting is required, the fee is paid for by the successful candidate and the expense is non-reimbursable. Offers of employment are contingent upon consenting to and successfully passing a drug screening test, negative results are reimbursable.
