As both the primary resource for community mental health and community primary care services to the uninsured and under-served, our mission is to bridge the mental health/physical health gap by providing integrated healthcare to our most vulnerable citizens.

Physical healthcare is a core component of the basic services provided to persons with mental illness. Ensuring access to physical healthcare while integrating that care with mental health services is critical to ensuring comprehensive treatment.

Our ever-expanding team of professionals serve as active participants in the transition to an integrated care model and the seamless provision of care to patients with chronic conditions.

Achieving the goal of integrated care not only increases access to physical and mental health services it also reduces care duplication and helps address the competition for declining healthcare resources.

Through the creation and staffing of this new position, coupled with the integrated delivery of physical and mental health care, we will ensure our clients receive the highest quality, most effective health care services possible.

## **Education:**

Graduation from an approved school of medicine with an MD or DO degree, completion of an approved residency program in psychiatry, and board certified as a Psychiatrist.

## **Experience:**

Five years of psychiatric practice experience and five years of increasing managerial and leadership responsibilities.

- National Board Certification as a Psychiatrist
- DEA Certificate

- Current BLS/CPR
- Diploma
- CV or Resume
