Smokefree Workplace Ordinance



The City of Eugene enacts a smokefree workplace ordinance which includes bars and restaurants.

2005

Tobacco Free Hospital



PeaceHealth Oregon Region Hospitals adopt a tobacco free policy affecting hospitals located in Eugene, Florence, Springfield, and Cottage Grove.

2008

Evidence-based Tobacco Cessation Policy

Tobacco cessation and relapse prevention intervention to clients of the Women, Infants and Children (WIC) program.

Youth Access to Tobacco Ordinance

The City of Eugene (2000), enacts an ordinance aimed at restricting youth access to tobacco. The ordinance:



- Requires retail tobacco outlets to be licensed
- Levies penalties to business owner rather than individual clerks who sold to minors
- Eliminates self-service to tobacco

Tobacco Sales Banned on Campus

EMU Board (Student Union) bans retail tobacco sales on University of Oregon campus

Partial Tobacco Free Hospital Campus Policy

McKenzie-Willamette hospital located in Springfield. Designated smoking shelter outside.

2005

Clean Indoor Air Ordinance Update

The City of Eugene updates the Clean Indoor Air Ordinance by:

- Banning smoking within 25 ft of publicly owned buildings.
- Outdoor smoking areas must be 75% open to the outdoors.
