



Lane County Citizens: Your Participation is Requested!

Lane County has recently begun an important project to develop 20-year population forecasts. These forecasts will be long-range estimates of the future population of the county, its cities and rural areas.

The forecasts developed through this project will be used to determine future city and county needs for housing, jobs, transportation, water and sanitary sewer systems, fire and police stations, and parks. City, county and community service providers such as school districts and hospitals may also rely on these forecasts to plan for future expansions.

Broad-based public participation is critical in the development of accurate and legitimate population forecasts. A **kick-off meeting** to describe this project and seek public input will be held on **Tuesday, December 2, at 6:00 p.m. in Harris Hall of the Lane County Public Service Building, 125 East 8th Avenue, Eugene.**
