Lane County's pavement preservation projects this year consist of asphalt overlays and sidewalk repairs on Pioneer Parkway (East & West), Harlow Road (Springfield), and Hayden Bridge Way/Road. Access will be limited at times while crews work and materials cure. Bicycle and pedestrian access will also be limited. It is our intent to keep at least one lane of traffic and one sidewalk open at all times. We are also concerned about the safety of children and pets that may get close to machinery or come into contact with hot oil materials.

**It is important that you not park your vehicles in the roadway** if you live along one of the roads identified as receiving a treatment. Lane County will tow, at the owner's expense, any vehicle that is preventing crews from performing work.

## **2010 Asphalt Overlays**

(Approx. \$1,800,000)

Under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA), or Federal Stimulus Bill, Lane County has been awarded funds for overlays of Pioneer Parkway, Harlow Road (Springfield) and Hayden Bridge Road in the summer of 2010.

In an attempt to give you some idea of the work schedule, please read below, however, keep in mind that this is subject to change due to a variety of factors including weather and materials availability. Keep up at the information sources on the front page for the latest information.



Starting in May, contractor crews will be in the area. Work will occur between 7:00 a.m. and approximately 7:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. The contractor for this project is Wildish Construction Company of Eugene. They will begin with isolated repairs in the roadways designed to strengthen the base in preparation for the overlay. Also, during this time, they will begin curb, gutter and sidewalk replacements along the construction areas. The contractor is required to open a minimum of two lanes (one for each direction of travel) at the end of each work day. Sidewalk closures may be more permanent as work continues and materials cure. The contractor is expected to leave at least one continuous sidewalk open during the project and pedestrians should be aware of and obey sidewalk closure signage. This will mean pedestrians will have to cross to another side of the street at various locations throughout the project.



During the month of June, Wildish will be diverted to another project at the Eugene Airport. There may be some isolated preparation work that continues on the overlay project, but it will be less intense for the month of June.

In July, Wildish will be back and begin the process of “roto-milling” the existing pavement; removing the top several inches of asphalt along the project length and then laying several layers of new asphalt. Again, at least two traffic lanes will be open by the end of work each day throughout the project life.

In October, the project will wrap up with the replacement of landscaping in the sidewalk repair areas.

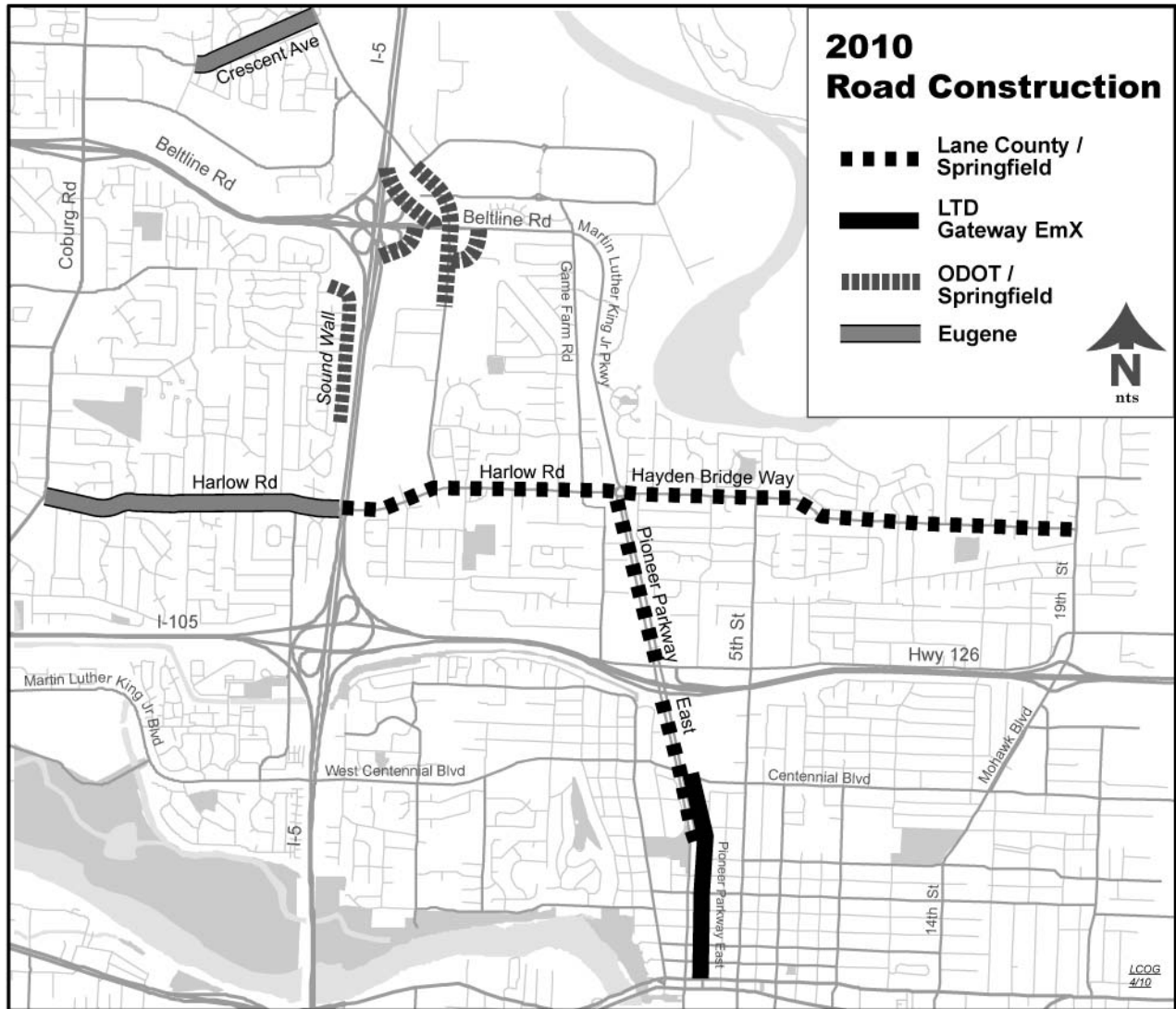
## **Protect your pets!**

The overlay process uses hot oil that is applied at more than 230° F and can cause serious burns to animal paws as well as sticking to, and burning, fur. **Please take the necessary extra precautions to protect your pets from this hazard.** Keep your pets inside as much as possible. When pets are taken outside, use a leash or keep them in an enclosed area. We need your help. No one wants to see your pets hurt.
