DETAILS:

The Lane County Sheriff's Office requests that persons voluntarily stay off County rivers due to high flow rates and large amounts of floating or partially submerged trees, logs, and miscellaneous debris.

Recent rainfall has generated high amounts of both soil and tree erosion that make the use of both motorized and non-motorized watercraft extremely hazardous. These high flow rates may last from several days up to a week.

This request is voluntary in nature and a public safety advisory only. If persons choose to recreate on any Lane Counties waterways, it is highly recommended they wear appropriate personal floatation devices.
